The Department of History is pleased to announce its Annual Graduate Student Historical Studies Conference to take place April 13-14, 2012. This year’s theme is “Borders, Boundaries and Beyond.” We invite graduate students and advanced undergraduates from across the social sciences and the humanities to submit proposals for papers that adopt an interdisciplinary or transnational approach but we are also seeking papers that approach historical topics in more traditional ways. All submissions must be based on original research. In keeping with the theme of the conference, papers will be organized into panels that cross spatial, temporal, and disciplinary boundaries.

Send abstract of no more than 250 words and a short curriculum vita as an attachment to histconf@cmich.edu. Preference will be given to papers received during the early submission period which ends November 15, 2011. The deadline for regular submission is January 31, 2012.
