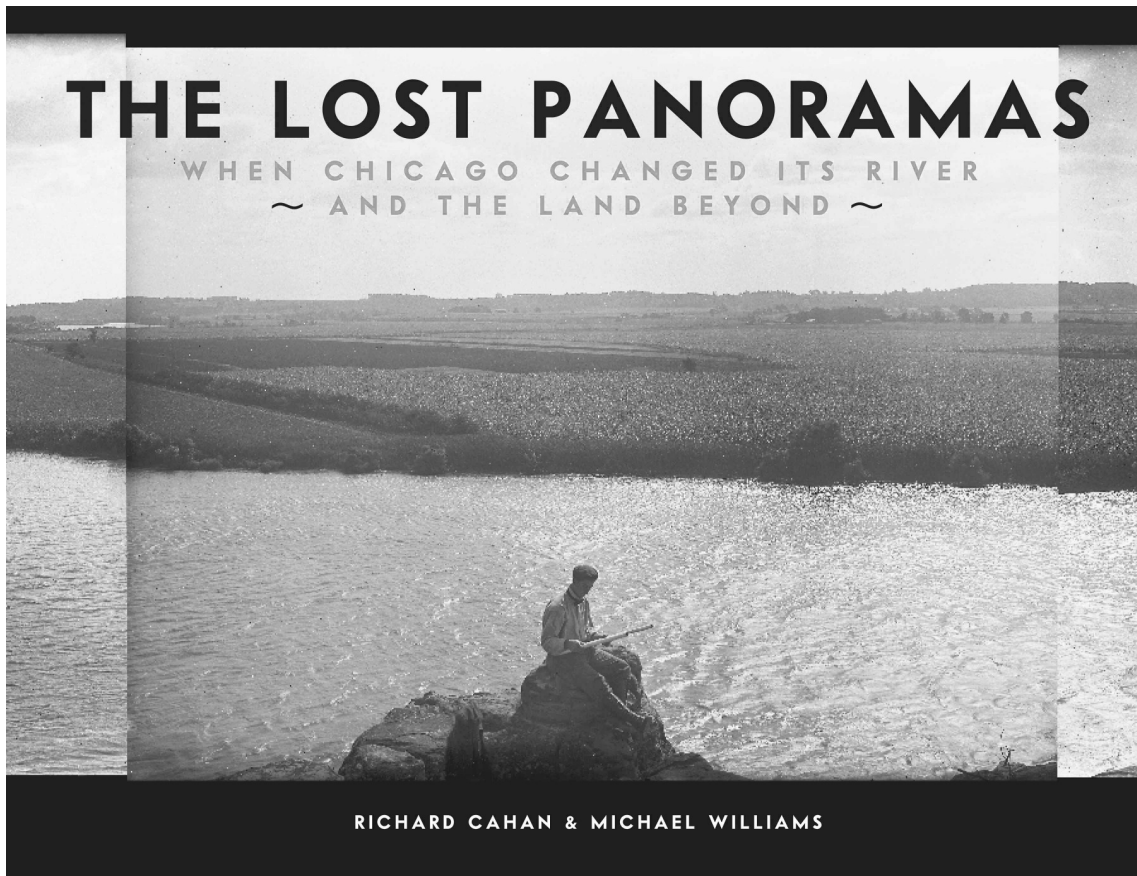


Becoming a Book Publisher
